Report on the Audit of Standalone Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying Statement of Standalone Financial Results of HEXA TRADEX LIMITED ('the Company') for the quarter ended March 31, 2023 and year to the date for the period from 1st April 2022 to 31st March 2023 ("the statement"), attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("the Listing Regulations").

- 2. The delisting of equity shares of Hexa Tradex Limited initiated by the acquirers has been completed including payment to all shareholders who offered their shares under this process. The necessary final application for delisting of shares has been filed with BSE and NSE which is pending for approval.
- 3.
